A faculty position

## Foundation Vinetum-Professor for Bee Health

is available within the Department of Clinical Research and Veterinary Public Health, Vetsuisse Faculty, University of Bern. Depending on the qualification of the applicants the position will be filled at the rank of “Assistant Professor”, “Extraordinariat” or “Ordinariat” (the two latter categories correspond to full professor, with tenure). The holder of the position will be the head of the new Institute of Bee Health. The new professor will be physically located at the Center of Bee Research (ZBF), which is a part of the Agroscope federal research organization. Close collaborations between the new professor and the ZBF are expected.

**Requirements:** Applicants must hold a PhD degree as well as substantial expertise in teaching and research in a relevant discipline, such as e.g. bee pathology, physiology, genetics, disease management or preventive medicine. Documented extramural funding and an adequate list of publications are further requirements for a successful application. Women are especially encouraged to apply in accordance with the University of Bern’s efforts to increase the number of female faculty members.

**Duties:** It is expected that the future position holder will establish and maintain an internationally competitive research activity relevant to bee health. Additionally, the future professor for bee health has to organize the undergraduate teaching in all aspects of bee science for students of veterinary medicine and biology. The future professor shall also supervise masters’ and PhD theses.
